(C105 SCHOOL LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C105 School Lane, Downholland from the southern boundary of Haskayne Playing Fields to the southern boundary of property number 149
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U968 Moss Lane, Downholland – C103 Riding Lane, Haskayne and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water connection replacement works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
